## Investment objective

The Sub-Fund aims to provide income and modest capital growth over the medium to long term through the implementation of an actively managed investment strategy. The Sub-Fund invests in a diversified range of eligible global assets including but not limited to equities (and equity-related securities), bonds, currencies and cash and its equivalent. Exposure to each of the asset classes will be primarily through: direct equity and debt securities (including high yield securities, CMBS, ABS, MBS and convertible bonds), units of undertakings for collective investment, exchange traded funds, money market instruments and index futures. In addition, the Sub-Fund may invest in swaps, total return swaps, options and foreign exchange forwards, each of which may be traded through recognised exchanges or via the over-the-counter markets. The Sub-Fund may also invest up to 10% in aggregate of its net assets in Alternative Asset Classes. This objective may also be achieved through investments in other sub-funds of the SICAV. This Sub-Fund may also invest up to 5% in aggregate of its net assets in Distressed Securities and Defaulted Securities and up to 5% of its net assets in Contingent Convertible Bonds ("CoCos").
