### Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide long term capital growth and income by investing in a portfolio of Indian shares.

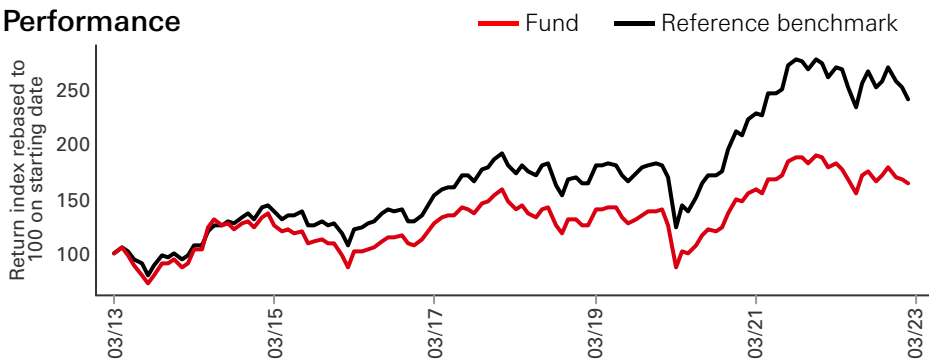
### Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed. In normal market conditions, the Fund will invest at least 90% of its assets in shares (or securities similar to shares) of companies of any size, that are based in, or carry out most of their business in India. The Fund may invest up to 30% in a combination of participation notes and convertible securities. The Fund will not invest more than 10% in Real Estate Investment Trusts and up to 10% in other funds. See the Prospectus for a full description of the investment objectives and derivative usage.

### Main risks

- The Fund's unit value can go up as well as down, and any capital invested in the Fund may be at risk.
- The value of investible securities can change over time due to a wide variety of factors, including but not limited to: political and economic news, government policy, changes in demographics, cultures and populations, natural or human-caused disasters etc.

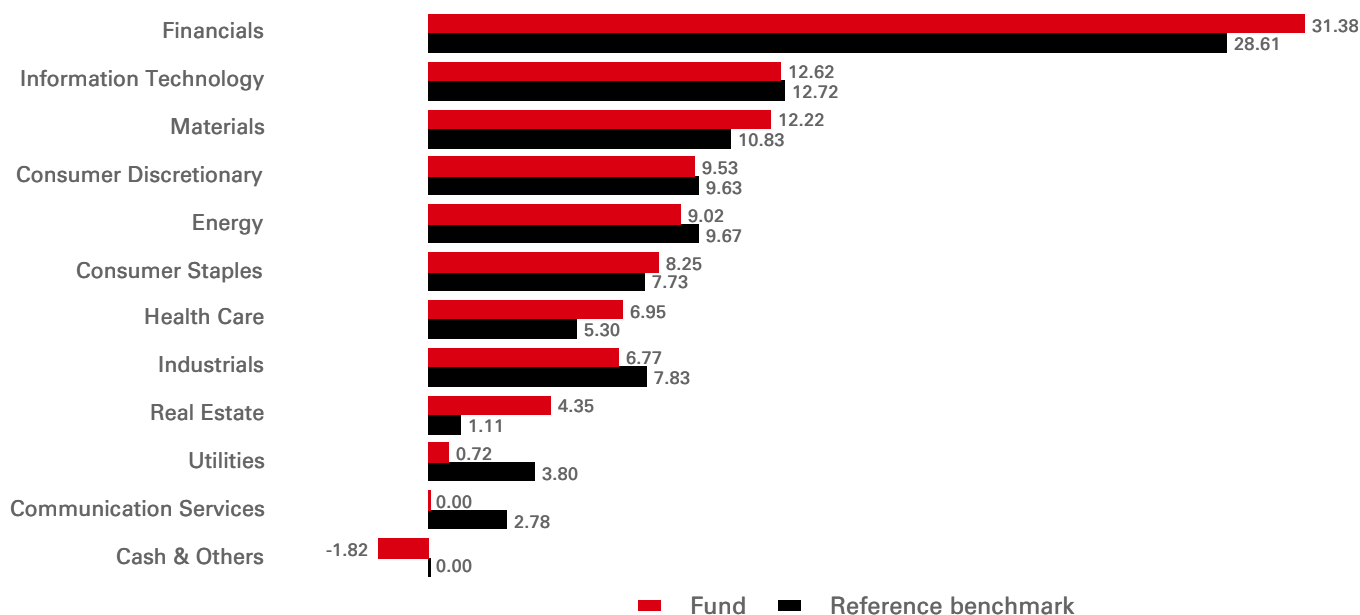

## Monthly performance commentary

Stock selection was positive for the month. Positive performance came from Financials and Materials, though this was partially offset by negative stock selection in Utilities.

Materials security, DALMIA BHARAT with total effect 0.11% was the top contributor. Additionally, Financials security, BAJAJ FINANCE was the second largest contributor with total effect 0.13%. Materials security, SRF LTD also contributed with total effect 0.13%.

On the other side, detractors included Utilities security ADANI GREEN ENERGY with total effect -0.13%, Consumer Discretionary holding FSN E COMMERCE VENTURES with total effect -0.11%, and Industrials holding ADANI ENTERPRISES with total effect -0.10%.

Sector allocation effects are residual to stock selection. At the sector level, effects were negative, given an underweight exposure to Utilities.

Annually distribution is 1; semi-annually distribution is 2; quarterly distribution is 4; monthly distribution is 12. The annualised dividend yield is calculated based on the dividend distribution on the relevant date with dividend reinvested, and may be higher or lower than the actual annual dividend yield.
