Investment Objective[~]

The Fund aims to maximize total returns from a combination of income generation and potential capital appreciation by investing primarily in a portfolio of fixed income securities issued by governments, agencies, supnationals and corporations in Asia (which shall include Australia and New Zealand). To meet its objective the Fund will invest at least 85% of its net assets in USD- denominated fixed income and fixed income-related securities of companies domiciled in, traded in and/or with substantial business interests in Asia and/or governments and government-related issuers located in Asia, who demonstrate strong sustainability attributes relative to peers or have demonstrated improving sustainability attributes.
